Abstracts should be in IMRD (Introduction, Methods, Result & Discussion) format with a word format in font style of Times New Roman, Font size 10, Line spacing 1.5 and max. word limit i.e. 250. Only research studies will be accepted for the conference. The submitted abstracts will be scrutinized by the scientific committee and the acceptance/ rejection of the abstracts will be intimated through e-mail. The time allotted for oral presentation is 10 minutes. Certificates will be awarded only to the presenting author. Researcher can add his/ her guide name with research abstract.

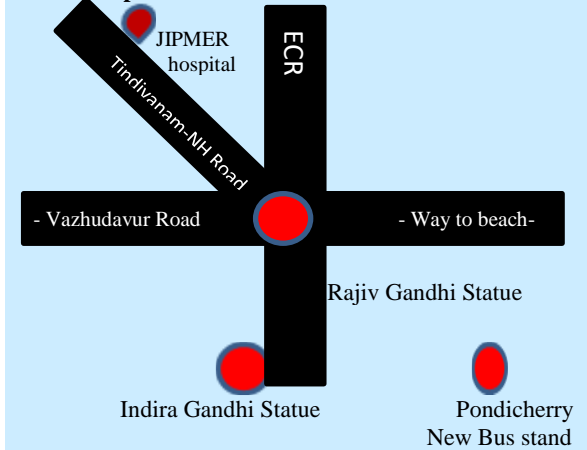
Airport : Chennai airport connected with major cities (Mumbai, Calcutta, Delhi etc.,)
