Prof. Vikram Kate was the recipient of the prestigious **Dr. Das Mohapatra Oration Award** at 82nd National Conference of the Association of Surgeons of India held at Mumbai from 21st to 24th December 2022. Prof. Kate delivered his oration lecture on “**Corrosive Gastroesophageal Strictures – Lessons learnt from three decades of experience.** Dr. Mohapatra did his undergraduate and postgraduate medical education at the Prince of Wales Medical College, Patna, Bihar. He then went to United Kingdom for further training and got his Fellowship of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh in 1947. He worked as Principal of SCB Medical College, Cuttack, Orissa and finally retired from Government Service as Director of Medical Education of Odisha. In consideration of his tremendous contribution to the growth of surgery in this country and in recognition of his academic excellence, The ASI instituted an Oration in his name in the year 1996.
