Young Medical Faculty Ph.D. program (2024)

- The program aims to motivate young medical faculty members, particularly from clinical departments, to pursue Ph.D. in the biomedical field, with the goal of creating a pool of young physician-scientists in the country who can further undertake impactful biomedical research.
- Nominated and selected medical faculty from JIPMER can register under ongoing PhD program in JIPMER or can register with AcSIR ICMR-Faculty of Medical Research (FMR).
- The Ph.D. program will be in strict compliance with academic and administrative requirements of the university (JIPMER or AcSIR) where the candidate is registered including stipulated timelines.
- The Ph.D. will be awarded by the university where the candidate is registered, either JIPMER or AcSIR-ICMR FMR
- ICMR will provide the faculty members registered for PhD unencumbered and unrestricted access (except specified laboratories where it is not permissible) to all the premises and infrastructure, including plant and machineries, equipment, instruments, tools etc considered relevant to the research and/or academic pursuit in the specified subject area(s), free of cost unless decided otherwise with mutual agreement.
- For candidates registered with AcSIR-ICMR FMR: Dean ICMR FM, in consultation with JIPMER will design and implement monitoring framework for PhD candidates including that for course work and milestone-based research progress. The supervisors will be responsible for achieving milestones during and after project completion. For these registered with JIPMER, the institute will do the same.
- DHR-ICMR will provide a research grant based on the approved budget for every candidate selected and registered under this program with a ceiling of INR 50 lacs/candidate. While supportive manpower (such as outsourced field staff, data entry operator and laboratory technicians) will be permissible, project scientists or SRF/JRF cannot be hired under this grant. The fund can also be utilised for travel, consumables, patient care, and other miscellaneous costs.
