

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES – JIPMER MBBS 2020

The list of certificates to be submitted at the time of admission is detailed in the **JIPMER MBBS 2020 Prospectus and the admission procedure SOP uploaded on JIPMER website.**

In addition, to re-emphasize the mandatory certificates necessary for availing constitutional or horizontal or domicile reservation, candidates are advised to verify the certificates detailed below against their respective category before reporting to JIPMER for admission to MBBS course

NOTE: Failure to produce any of the certificates detailed below in original and their photocopies during verification will lead to forfeiture of the allotted seat. No additional time or opportunity will be provided for producing the certificates.

Other Backward Class (OBC) Category

1. Valid **Other Backward Class (OBC) - Non-Creamy Layer (NCL)** certificate as detailed in **JIPMER MBBS 2020 Prospectus page number 10** should be submitted.
2. Candidates are instructed to refer to the central list of Other Backward Class (OBC) categories at http://www.ncbc.nic.in/User_Panel/CentralListStateView.aspx. **Community name should be there in the central list**
3. The certificate format should be as mentioned in the NTA NEET 2020 Information Bulletin, page 84, **Appendix XI: Proforma for Other Backward Class (OBC-NCL) certificate.**
4. The certificate should be valid i.e the date of issue of the certificate should be on or after **01-10-2019**
5. If OBC & NCL certificates are separate, the candidates should submit both the certificates.

Please note:

The certificates will not be accepted,

If it is in any other format other than as detailed in **Appendix XI**

If 'non-creamy layer' or 'does not belong to creamy layer/section' is not mentioned

If community /subcaste is not listed in the central list

If the certificate was issued prior to **01-10-2019**

Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe (SC/ST) Category

1. **Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Community Certificate, should be obtained from the competent authority**
2. The certificate should be as per the format mentioned in the NTA NEET Information Bulletin page 83, Appendix X: Proforma for Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Certificate.

Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)s Category

1. Candidates should produce the required Income & Asset Certificate as (as mentioned in the NTA NEET Information Bulletin)
2. The certificate should be issued by competent authority not below the **rank of Tehsildar**
3. **INCOME CERTIFICATE** will not be considered equivalent to EWSs certificate under any circumstances

Please note:

Eligibility for EWS: applicants who are not covered under the scheme of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh (Rupees eight lakh only) are to be identified as EWSs for benefit of reservation. Income shall also include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession, etc. for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWS, irrespective of the family income:- i. 5 acres of agricultural land and above; ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above; iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities; iv. Residential plot of 200 sq. yards and above in areas other than the notified municipalities. The property held by a "Family" in different locations or different places/ cities would be clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status. (Page 10 of 23 JIPMER MBBS Prospectus 2020 JIPMER Puducherry and JIPMER Karaikal)

The term "Family" for this purpose will include the person who seeks benefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years. (Ref: Office Memorandum F.No.36039/1/2019 dated 31st January 2019 by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pension & F.No. A11013/01/2019 dated 28th February 2019 by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India Income & Asset Certificate must be in the format as mentioned in the NTA NEET 2020 Information bulletin, & As per the OM No. 20013/01/2018-BC-II dated January 17, 2019 issued by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment and the OM No. 12-4/2019-U1 dated 17.01.2019 as well as the Letters No 35-2/2019-T.S.I dated 21.01.2019, 01.02.2019, 04.02.2019 and 15.02.2019 of MHRD Department of Higher Education regarding implementation of reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) for admission in Central Educational Institutions).

Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwD)

1. Candidates should submit Medical Certificate issued only from the **authorized centers** as listed page no 47 of UG MCC counseling scheme for qualified physically handicapped (PH) candidates for All India quota/central universities –UG (MBBS/BDS)
2. No other medical certificate will be accepted under any circumstances

Puducherry Domicile

1. Candidates should submit **latest** Residence Certificate / Employer Certificate as required in the JIPMER MBBS 2020 Prospectus page number 11 and 12. Refer to Annexure I in the same document.

NRI/OCI

1. Candidates should produce Recent NRI Status certificate of the parent or candidate issued by the Indian Embassy of the respective Country with the Embassy seal
2. Certificate of Registration for Overseas Citizen of India.
3. Payment should be made only in US Dollars
