The protocols approved with modifications need to be submitted as one original copy with the changes highlighted with a yellow highlighter. **Kindly submit corrected protocol along with covering letter enumerating the comments from the PGRMC minutes for their proposal, with point-to-point reply of where the revision has been highlighted.**

All resubmissions and modified protocols should be submitted to the office of undersigned by 16th May 2015.

If the revision is satisfactory, the approval certificate will be issued after consulting the Dean Research. Otherwise, they need to submit two copies of proposal for its approval and it will be considered as fresh proposal.
