

## **Aseptic Glove donning/doffing skill module released by the Department of Surgery, JIPMER, Karaikal**

On 6th December 2024, the Department of Surgery, JIPMER, Karaikal unveiled a comprehensive module on Aseptic Donning and Doffing of Gloves for Clinical Practice Version 1. The official release event was part of a Medical Education Program held at the third-floor lecture hall, Academic Building, JIPMER, Karaikal. The event was graced by the presence of The Dean of JIPMER, Karaikal, who formally launched the module.
