2. Guidelines for Stray Vacancy Round for NEET-Under-Graduate Courses (MBBS/BDS) – 2020-21 dated 04.01.2020

The Stray Vacancy Round of counselling for filling up the MBBS seats for 2020 session for JIPMER Puducherry and Karaikal Campuses which remained vacant after Mop Up Round of counseling and other seats might fall vacant by way of surrender/resignation etc. (after confirmation in 1st, 2nd and Mop up round) will be held on 10.01.2021 (Sunday).

As per the GUIDELINES FOR STRAY VACANCY ROUND FOR NEET-UNDER-GRADUATE COURSES (MBBS/BDS) -2020-21 announced by the Medical Counselling Committee, DGHS on 4th January 2021, the list of shortlisted candidates based on merit eligible to participate in the JIPMER stray vacancy round, ten times the number of vacant seats at JIPMER Karaikal in each category, is appended (APPENDIX - A). The eligible candidates should report in person to participate in the stray vacancy round of counselling at JIPMER Puducherry along with the original certificates. **Those who are not on the list will not be entertained for counselling.**

Step I: Registration

All the candidates are instructed to fill and submit online student verification form on or before 09.01.2021, 02:00 PM.

Step II: Verification of Original certificates:

The candidates will be allowed to participate in the counselling process only after physical verification of the registration slip and all the original certificates as per **Appendix- B**.

Candidates without original certificates will not be allowed to participate in the counselling process. In case of any discrepancy in the certificates related to constitutional reservation, candidates will be permitted to participate only under UR category

Step III: Display of Category wise merit list:

A category wise merit list will be drawn amongst, those registered candidates who are physically present and whose original certificates are verified and found in order.

Step IV: Counselling for eligible candidates:

Counselling session will be done category wise viz., UR, EWS, OBC, SC/ST based on the merit list.

NOTE:

- Stray Vacancy round will be conducted in Offline mode only as per the schedule.
- If any OBC seat remains vacant after counseling for OBC seats, all vacant seats will be transferred to UR category and will be offered to UR candidates on merit.
- If any EWS seat remains vacant after counseling for EWS seats, all vacant seats will be transferred to UR category and will be offered to UR candidates on merit.
- In case of SC/ST counseling, if any ST seat(s) remain vacant, these will be transferred to SC category, in case any SC seat remains vacant after counseling for SC seat, all vacant seats in SC category will be transferred to UR category and will be offered to UR candidates based on merit.
- Thus, UR candidates should therefore, stay back till the completion of the stray vacancy round of counseling for all categories.
- Candidates already holding a seat in Round-I Round-2 and Mop-up round will not be allow to participate in the Stray Vacancy Round.
- The allocation of seats will be made strictly as per rank/merit of candidates.

b) For SC/ST Category:

SC/ST certificate must be in the format as mentioned in the **Annexure II**.

c) For EWS category:

Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) shall be applicable as per Govt. of India policy Office Memorandum No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) DoPT dated 19th January 2019 and 31st January 2019. EWSs Candidates will attach current certificate issued by the competent authority in the form prescribed as per **Annexure III**.

The certificate should be issued by the Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar/Dy. Tahsildar if he/she belongs to SC/ST/OBC/EWS category. In case the certificates in regional language, the English version of the certificate duly attested by a Gazetted Officer should also be furnished.

12. For Non-Resident Indian candidates:

Recent NRI Status certificate of the parent or candidate issued by the Indian Embassy of the respective Country with the Embassy seal.

13. For Overseas Citizen of India: Certificate of Registration for Overseas Citizen of India.

Candidate should bring all original documents and photocopies of all necessary documents along with 6 passport size photographs on the day of counselling.



COMMON INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

Please read thoroughly the MBBS Prospectus 2020 for JIPMER available on jipmer.edu.in for complete admission process (pages 13 to 16 in particular). Subject to certificate verification, medical board examination, payment of fees, and satisfying all the admission criteria, admission orders will be issued to the students.

NOTE: Failure to produce any of the required certificates in original and their photocopies during verification will lead to forfeiture of the allotted seat. No additional time or opportunity will be provided for producing the certificates.

Medical Examination: The candidates will undergo medical examination by a duly constituted board at International Hostel (for girls and boys) on **11.01.2021** at 10:00 AM.

Mode of Payment for academic fees:

Demand draft for Rs. 12,620/-: The selected candidates should submit a Demand Draft for the amount Rs. 12,620/- for payment towards academic fee. The Demand Draft should be made in favour of the Director, JIPMER, Puducherry payable at Puducherry.

Hostel accommodation: Hostel accommodation will be provided only to outstation students after the completion of quarantine and admission process. The details are given in the Hostel Manual on JIPMER website.


The candidates opting for hostel should pay the following hostel charges before allotment of a room:

- Establishment charges (per annum, non-refundable) - Rs. 6,000/-
- Hostel caution deposit (refundable) - Rs. 5,000/-
- Hostel mess deposit (refundable) - Rs. 3,000/-

Hostel room rent (double sharing, per annum, paid at the beginning of the year) - Rs. 6,000/-
