Outreach Chest X ray camp – Thuthipet

Outreach Chest X ray camp was conducted at Thuthipet village on 05.12.2025 along with the NCD clinic. Vulnerable population attending the NCD clinic are screened. Totally 45 Chest x ray have been taken. Chest x rays strongly suggestive of TB were sent for sputum CB NAAT examination. Seven sputum samples were sent and all are negative.



No Scalpel Vasectomy awareness campaign

No Scalpel Vasectomy awareness activity has been conducted in ANC clinic (10.12.25) and under five immunization clinics (11.12.25). All the eligible couples who attended the meeting were motivated to adopt NSV. Other available contraceptive methods were explained in detail. Queries were clarified at the end of the session.



Water sanitation activities – Distribution of essential supplies to the tank operators

As follow up of engagement with tank operators of service area to improve water quality, basic cleaning materials were provided to tank operators from JIRHC on 12.12.2025.



Outreach Yoga session

As a part of wellness activities under comprehensive health care of AAM, Yoga session was conducted in Thondamanatham community hall on 12/12/25. Around 22 beneficiaries attended the session.



Planning and Social mobilization for IPPI

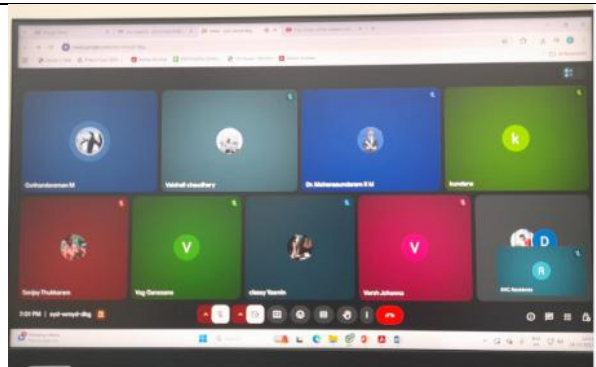
The state government meeting has been attended by the JRHC team. The vehicle availability, human resources, and budget have been explained. Planned activities include

1. Visit to booths - for planning workflow and cleaning
2. Training of interns, MPH, and nursing students for IPPI and anthropometry
3. Meeting with staff of JRHC for IPPI



IPPI online training session

Intensified Pulse Polio Immunisation (IPPI) Training in online mode has been completed for JRs, nursing students, and MPH students. Around 35 members attended the meeting. Booth activity and anthropometry assessment have been explained.



IPPI – 2026

Five booths were set for IPPI in the service areas of JIPMER Rural Health Centre. Totally 755 children were immunised with Oral polio vaccine on the booth day. House to house visits were done on the subsequent two days to cover the unimmunised children. Complete immunisation of under 5 children was ensured at the end of campaign.



Palliative care training for Caregivers

A training session was conducted for caregivers of patients with palliative needs and volunteers in the service area. Around 25 people attended the session including members from NGO Sanjeevan. Sessions included - Palliative services in RHC, Communication skills and Basic nursing skills.



JIPMER internal team visit - NQAS

Internal National Quality Assurance Standards (NQAS) assessment was conducted by JIPMER Quality team. Gaps were assessed under various areas of concern of NQAS and corrective actions were suggested. Quality circle team meeting of JRHC is scheduled on the month of January.



Disability screening camp

Disability screening camp was conducted by ALIMCO (Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India) and our team in JRHC to identify beneficiaries eligible for receiving aids. People from all four service area were mobilised. A total of 69 people attended the camp and details were collected for eligibility of Assistive technology devices including Hearing aids



Mock drill for conducting labour

A mock drill was conducted in the labour room of the JRHC to assess preparedness for obstetric emergencies. The drill evaluated adherence to standard treatment protocols, functionality of equipment, availability of essential drugs, and staff response. Corrective actions including strengthening supplies, refresher training were noted
