**Topic: Difficult airways in neonates**

**Summary:** Neonatal trainees need to acquire several procedural skills during their training. Airway management is one such core skill and proficiency in managing the difficult airway is lifesaving in an acute emergency. Skills training in airway management with simple guidelines enable rapid decisions to be made at times of crises and the frequent reinforcement of such training leads to skill retention, improved knowledge, a boosting of confidence and improve patient outcomes. We will be presenting three difficult neonatal airway cases managed in the unit followed by our 5 years experience of managing such cases. Department will also be sharing the experience in training doctors on difficult airways using an innovative simulator.
