01/12/2025

An awareness health talk on vasectomy was conducted in the ANC clinic to promote informed family-planning choices. The session covered the procedure, its safety, effectiveness, and common misconceptions. 15 Participants were present.

Under the Tobacco-Free Youth Campaign, the JIUHC team conducted a skit highlighting substance abuse—how peer pressure and external influences can lead students to experiment with harmful substances, their negative impact on health, academic performance, and overall quality of life. The skit emphasized the *importance of staying substance-free* and encouraged students to seek support from *teachers, parents, or the JUHC team* whenever needed.



Following the skit, an Awareness talk was delivered by the PHNO and Resident, reinforcing the message and addressing students' questions. A total of 40 students actively participated in the session .

an 100-Day TB Campaign was conducted at JUHC in the NCD Clinic. A total of 50 patients underwent X-ray screening, and samples were collected from 8 patients who showed abnormalities on their X-rays.
